



Event Highlights:

1. Documentary Screening on the occasion of Anti-Ragging Day on 12th August 2023

On the inaugural day of the Anti-Ragging Week, the Anti-Ragging Cell organized a documentary screening in each class. The documentary video focused on the consequences of ragging and its psychological effects on victims. Additionally, the documentary was displayed on the display screens situated on each floor of the college building.








Screening of Documentary video on Anti-Ragging

3. Display of Anti-Ragging Posters:



4. Talk on Provisions of the Anti-Ragging Act Legislation:

As part of the educational initiative, Advocate Prajakta Lolayekar enlightened the audience on the provisions of Anti Ragging legislation. She spoke as to how ragging is an evil and affects the mental as well physical well-being of a student. The resource person made a special reference to the penal provisions for the offence of ragging. The students were also sensitised on the preventive measures which every educational institute is required to adopt to prevent ragging. Ms. Lolayekar elucidated the legal aspects of the act, emphasized the rights of students, and shed light on the procedures to report and combat ragging incidents. Her expertise in the field of law provided valuable insights to the student participants.
