## Faculty Development Programme

The IQAC, of the College organised a State Level Faculty Development Programme on 'Guidelines for Setting Examination Question Papers and Assessing Answer Books' on the 30th of August, 2019. Dr. Renji George Ambaloor, Deputy Director, DHE and Dr. Shekar Naik, Assistant Director, DHE, Goa were the Resource Persons for the Workshop.

Dr. Renji George spoke on the Modalities of setting a Question Paper. He elaborated on the scope, length and difficulty level of the question paper to be set by the concerned teacher. Dr. Shekar Naik spoke about 'Blooms Taxonomy' which provides a systematic way of describing how a learners performance grows in complexity when mastering academic tasks. He explained how the six levels of Blooms Taxonomy can be used in assessing a students performance. Dr. Renji George later spoke about the assessment of answer books based on the University Ordinance. The session ended with queries being answered by the Resource Persons.





## Talk on Creating Consciousness about the Snakes - Our Pal

The College had organized a talk on creating consciousness about snakes. The Resource Person was Mr. Shricharan Dessai, President, SAWE (Study & Awareness of Wildlife & Environment). The team showed the students around six to seven different types of venomous and non-venomous snakes like Rat Snake, Pit Viper and the Spectacle Cobra. He informed us that there are around 40 different species of snakes and only four of them are venomous, five to six are mildly venomous and the remaining are non-venomous. Snakes will harm us only if we chase them or try to hurt them as they are scared for their lives. They bite only to protect themselves, he added.
