A Two- Day National Seminar on "**Consumer Behaviour: Marketing Resources**" was conducted by the Department of Commerce on February 22nd & 23rd, 2019. The Chief Guest was Dr. Renji George, Dy. Director, Directorate of Higher Education. He spoke about the importance of the consumer and the study of their behavior. The Key Note Speaker Prof Koshy Abraham, IIM, Ahmedabad, also spoke about the importance of the consumer. He said that the consumer should be respected by the sellers and they should be committed and sincere towards their consumers.



The International Multidisciplinary Quarterly Research Journal "Ajanta" was released at the hands of the Key Note Speaker Prof Koshy Abraham. A book release on "Complaint Management in the Airline Industry: An Application of Justice Theory" published by Dr. Fatima De Souza, was released by Prof. Purva Hegde Dessai, Department of Management Studies, Goa University.

Four Technical sessions were conducted for which the Keynote speakers were, Prof Nandkumar Mekoth, Prof Nilesh Borde, Prof Purva Hegde Dessai, Dept. of Management Studies, Goa University and Dr Pradeep Salgaonkar, Director, SALDOTS Academy.

The keynote address was given by Adv. Jagdish Prabhudesai on the second day. He spoke on legal framework and Consumer Redressal mechanisms to be followed. The last technical session on 'Advertising and its Impact' was chaired by Dr. Mahesh Pai, Principal of Goa College of Home Science who gave his views on the effect of advertisements on children.

Dr. Sanjay Dessai, Principal, CES College of Arts and Science, Cuncolim, Goa, and Dr. Gajanan Madiwal, Principal, chaired the fifth and sixth sessions respectively. The Seminar concluded by the Vote of Thanks being given by Ms. Rupali Sangodkar for which the Guest of Honour was Dr. Mahesh Pai.



A Two day National Seminar on "**The Indian Economy: Emerging Trends, Issues and Challenges**" was organized by the Department of Economics, Margao, in association with the Directorate of Higher Education, Government of Goa on 22nd & 23rd March, 2019. The Chief Guest of the Seminar was Dr. R. S. Deshpande, former Director of Institute of Social & Economic Change, Bengaluru, & National Fellow, ICSSR. The Guest of Honour was Prof. P. K. Sudarsan, HoD,

Department of Economics, Goa University.

Prof. P.K. Sudarsan, during his address said that we should not be complacent with idea that we are the fastest growing economy in the world as India's image on the Human Development Index and World Hunger Index is very poor. Prof Deshpande spoke about the "Indian Economy's Tender Spots and Known Obstacles" in his address. The key note address was given by Prof. Jyoti Chandiramani who was of the opinion that health and environment were two important issues that need to be looked into, in our country.

The two day seminar thus witnessed a blend of both key note addresses by eminent economists and also included paper presentations by faculty drawn from various colleges within Goa as also from other states. The presentations touched upon a gamut of issues related to the economy-FDI, Monetary Policy, Skill India, Startups, Agriculture, Digital India, Banking etc.

STATE LEVEL SEMINAR

The Department of Economics organized a One Day State Level Seminar on “The Agriculture Sector in Goa: Towards Self Sustainable Development” on the 10th of January 2019. The seminar was a blend of interesting lectures delivered by resource persons directly involved in agrarian operations in the State as also research paper presentations. The resource persons for the seminar were Shri Dattaprasad Keshav Desai, Agricultural Zonal Officer, Margao- Government of Goa who spoke at length about the advances made in the state and more specifically in Neturlim with respect to Apiculture; Shri Mayuresh Shetye, Project Officer, Atal Gram Development Agency, Government of Goa, who explained about the successful experiment of growing strawberries in Goa and Shri Harish Usgaonkar, CTO, Letcetra Agritech who spoke on a Hydroponics – a relatively new initiative in agriculture in the state of Goa. A total of twenty one papers were presented in four technical sessions which also had student paper presenters.



Shri Vijay Sardessai, M.L.A, Fatorda Constituency and Minister for Agriculture, Government of Goa and Dr. Renji George Amballoor, Deputy Director of Higher Education, DHE, Government of Goa were the Chief Guests at the Inaugural and Valedictory respectively.



The Internal Complaints Committee of the College organized a One Day State Level Seminar on “**PREVENTION OF SEXUAL HARASSMENT AT WORKPLACE**” on the 1st of March 2019.

The programme comprised of two sessions. While one session helped the participants to identify a sexual predator and take preventive measures, the other threw light on what constitutes sexual harassment and the legal options available to a victim. The Resource Persons for the Seminar included noted Lawyer and Human Rights Activist, Adv. Albertina Almeida and Ms.

Kanan Thandy, a professional trainer in Body Language whose expertise is sought and used by the Law Enforcement Authorities in Goa.

Citing various cases Adv. Almeida threw light on what exactly constitutes a sexual offence at workplace. She elaborated on the role that the ICC has to essay in these matters and the course action that it has to take in the event of complaints.

Ms.Kanan Thandi through her lucid presentation made the participants aware of certain body postures and gestures of individuals which could help them identify whether they are sexual predators.



WORKSHOPS

A One Day State Level Workshop on “**leadership and Personality Development**” was organized by the College in association with Directorate of Sports and Youth Affairs, Goa, under the Youth Scheme. The Chief Guest for the inaugural was Mr. Prashant Naik, Chairman Ravindra Bhavan, Fatorda and Mr. Jose Gomes was the Guest of Honor Dr. Jorson Fernandes was the guest speaker and he spoke on “Why Sex is a closed door topic”. He stressed on the youth getting quality life education and stated the importance of having a mature dialogue and relationship with the youth. Ms. Caroline Stewart, a freelancer by profession took a session on grooming and spoke on personality development, leadership and striving to become successful in spite of odds.

Ms. Kethki Porob, Psychologist conducted a session on the power of the sub conscious mind. She said that our entire life can be changed if we think positively. Ms. Porob specified that problems in parenting arise because of lack of communication. Chief Guest for the valedictory function was Mr. Edwin Fernandes, Principal of Government ITI, Borda.

The Department of Commerce organized a One Day State Level Workshop on “**How to Write Minor / Major Research Projects**” in November, 2018. The Resource Person for this workshop was Prof. Purva Hegde Dessai, Department of Management Studies, Goa University. The objective of the workshop was to familiarize the participants with the steps to be followed in order to write minor/major research projects. The resource person highlighted the various fundamental aspects of writing research proposals such as identifying the research problem, literature survey and writing a quality research proposal.

The Directorate of Higher Education in collaboration with GCCE, Margao, Goa, organized a 3 Day training programme “**ASPIRE FOR EXCELLENCE**” for the teaching faculty, students and the administrative staff on 8th, 9th and 10th of December, 2018. The three day session started with an intensive workshop for faculties called ‘Achieve Excellence’. Fun games which taught laughter, team bonding and team work were played.
