	Strategic Planning	Achievement of the long-term goals of the college would require the co-ordination of various agencies/institutions.
		The realisation of goals such as creation of an educational hub with lateral meld of the three educational institutions viz. the Higher Secondary, the ITI and the College as also introduction of new graduate and post graduate programme would require the approval and sanction of the government/DHE as also the Goa University.
		The development of curriculum and courses by the faculty will be a pre-requisite for this roadmap to materialise.

6.	Action Plan	Various programmes related to academics, research and overall development of the college have been chalked out and listed in this document with the objective of developing the college into an 'Institution of Excellence' and achieving the goals embedded in the Vision and Mission statements of the college, both in letter and spirit.
		The action plan is to attempt and execute the goals set in a time bound manner. The achievement of the goals are realistic given the existence of a motivated faculty who have the requisite drive and experience to execute the goals set, more specifically in the short and medium term.
		The introduction of new academic programmes at the undergraduate/postgraduate level will be contingent upon the approval/permission of the Directorate of Higher Education and the affiliating University.
		In keeping with the spirit of the New Education Policy, the college proposes to stress on the multidisciplinary approach with a view of providing the student a more

holistic learning experience. Over a decade, the college plans to establish links between academia and industry and imbibe in the students not only life skills but a respect for diversity and plurality. The college also aims to integrate technology in the curriculum with a view of improving students' learning processes and outcomes. The introduction of the proposed degree programme in vocational education would give our students an edge over others in terms of skill-set development as also employability. The focus of the faculty will be on the all-round development of the student.

One of the key requirements in the realisation of the long-term goals listed out is infrastructure. While staggered timings and optimal utilisation of existing infrastructure can help in the conduct of newer courses, introduction of new educational programmes would require an enhancement in infrastructure in terms of classrooms. One of the basic long - term requirement/goal is therefore an improvement in the availability of infrastructure.
